

What is Module 1?

Module 1 is the basic workshop for teams of lay missionaries and pastor-mentors implementing the National Plan for Hispanic/Latino Ministries. The overall purpose of the training event is to assist teams of pastor-mentors and lay missionaries who want to:

- Develop or administer a community ministry involving Hispanics/Latinos
- Establish a Hispanic/Latino faith community
- Start a new Hispanic/Latino congregation or church school extension program
- Assist in the revitalization of an existing Hispanic or non-Hispanic church

Who should attend?

Persons who desire to work as teams in ministry with Hispanics/Latinos should attend. Persons who are only interested in the subject, but not committed to engaging in a team ministry at this time are encouraged to attend other exploring workshops. The Module training is only for those who are ready to engage in a ministry involving Hispanics/Latinos.

What constitutes a team?

A team consists of a pastor who serves as a mentor with one or more lay persons to assess the needs of their community, listen for God's leading, plan and carry out a ministry with Hispanics/Latinos. Spanish language proficiency is not a requisite.

FACILITATORS: All sessions will be led by trained facilitators and specialists in the National Plan for Hispanic/Latino Ministries including Vera Kenyon, Pastor Jorge Rodriguez, Deacon Rhoda Pittman Markus, and Pastor Ron Whitlatch.

LANGUAGE: All sessions will be conducted in either Spanish or English with simultaneous interpretation into the other language.

LODGING will be at the Center.

MEALS: All meals will be provided from Thursday dinner through Sunday lunch.

REGISTRATION: The registration fee is \$350 for lodging, food and materials. Participants from the Oregon-Idaho Conference may apply for a \$250 scholarship. Last date for registration is **September 30**. Make checks payable to "Oregon-Idaho UMC Conference." Because there is limited space, please register early.

TEAMS: Participants are expected to be part of a team consisting of a pastor-mentor and one or more lay missionaries.

CHILDCARE: You are encouraged to find your own childcare. Please notify us before September 30 if you need these services. Registration fee for each child: \$350.
